

Justice Verity McWilliam

On 2 May 2023, Verity Alexandra McWilliam was sworn in as a resident judge of the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory. This followed a period of 6 years' service as associate judge of the Court, the last two of those also including a joint commission as an acting judge.

Her Honour has worked in NSW as both a solicitor from 2002, and a barrister from 2006, in a broad range of practice areas, and as an associate to the Hon. Justice Mary Finn in the Appeal Division of the Family Court of Australia, and the Hon. Justice Beaumont and the Hon. Justice Madgwick in the Federal Court of Australia.

While at the NSW Bar, she also lectured variously in public law, federal constitutional law and litigation at the University of NSW, and in public law at the University of Sydney.

Justice McWilliam holds BA (Hons I)/LLB degrees from the Australian National University in 2000, and a Masters degree in International Law from the University of Sydney in 2005.
