NOTICE TO PRACTITIONERS

Change of date - Criminal Callover on 20 March 2023

- 1. Practitioners are advised that the criminal callover which was to take place on 20 March 2023 at 9am will now be held on **Tuesday 11 April 2023 at 9am**.
- 2. Practitioners are reminded at the callover representatives of the parties should have full instructions and be prepared to advise the Court as to:
 - whether the matter is to proceed by trial by jury or trial by judge alone (election having been filed);
 - any reason why a trial should be allocated to a particular judge;
 - whether there are any outstanding pre-trial applications or pre-trial hearings in the matter;
 - any prospects of the matter resolving without the need for a trial;
 - the names of counsel appearing in the matter;
 - counsel and witness unavailability during the sitting times listed below;
 - the expected duration of the trial;
 - any requirement for CCTV, video conferencing or the recording of evidence;
 - any other relevant matter which could affect the hearing of the trial.
- 3. Matters in the callover may be listed in any of the following weeks:
 - Week commencing 22 May 2023
 - Week commencing 29 May 2023
 - Week commencing 5 June 2023
 - Week commencing 12 June 2023
 - Week commencing 19 June 2023
 - Week commencing 17 July 2023
 - Week commencing 24 July 2023
 - Week commencing 31 July 2023; and
 - Week commencing 7 August 2023.

Any election for judge alone trial is to be filed **7 days** prior to the callover.

Parties are additionally advised that for this callover the court will not require the parties to file the callover instruction sheet with the Supreme Court Registry. Any party whose information has changed from that contained in their Pre-Trial Questionnaire is to file an **updated questionnaire no later than 7 days prior to the callover.**
