### SUPREME COURT LISTING DAYS AND TIMES – CHANGES TO REGISTRAR'S LISTS

3. Practitioners are advised that the following changes will be made to the listings for Originating Application Directions, Listing Hearings and the Appeal Index List for those matters listed in the week of 24 July 2023:

Listing Hearings move from Thursday to the preceding Tuesday	27 July 2023 at 10.15am	25 July 2023 at 10.15am
Appeal Index List moves from Thursday to the preceding Tuesday	27 July 2023 at 2.30pm	25 July 2023 at 2.30pm

4. Equivalent changes will be made to any matters currently listed in the Originating Application Directions, Listing Hearings and the Appeal Index List beyond the week of 24 July 2023.
