

## **Associate Judge David Mossop**

David Mossop was appointed as Master of the Supreme Court on 2 May 2013. At the time of his appointment he was a Magistrate and a Coroner of the Australian Capital Territory. He holds a Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Laws from the University of New South Wales and a Master of Laws (Public Law) from the Australian National University. He was admitted to practice as a solicitor in 1992. He practised as a barrister for 14 years from 1998 to 2011.

With the commencement of the *Courts Legislation Amendment Act 2015* (ACT) the title of the office of the “Master” of the ACT Supreme Court was changed to “Associate Judge” of the ACT Supreme Court. The change came into effect on 21 April 2015.
