NOTICE TO PRACTITIONERS

Updated Criminal Central listing Dates 2022

Practitioners are advised that due to the impact of the COVID-19 on court listings the Central Criminal and Central Civil listing periods will be combined during the period February 2022 – April 2022 and the number of listing weeks increased. Central Criminal listing periods for 2022 will be now be held as follows:

February/April sittings

(8 weeks) 14 Feburary to 14 April 2022 (inclusive)

May/June/July sittings

(7 weeks) 30 May to 15 July 2022 (inclusive)

August/September/October sittings

(7 weeks) 29 August to 14 October 2022 (inclusive)

November/December sittings

(2 weeks) 21 November to 2 December 2022 (inclusive)

If circumstances require, the Court may sit to conduct trials on dates other than those listed above. The list will be called over before a Judge. Each callover will be held at 9.30am on the following dates, unless otherwise advised by the Court:

Monday **28 February 2022** for the May/June/July 2022 sittings

Monday **9 May 2022** for the August/September/October 2022 sittings

Monday **8 August 2022** for the November/December 2022 sittings

Monday **7 November 2022** for the first 2023 sittings (TBA)

At the call over the representatives of the parties should have full instructions and be prepared to advise the Court as to:

- whether the matter is to proceed by trial by jury or a trial by judge alone (election having been filed)
- any reason why a trial should be allocated to a particular judge
- whether there are any pre trial applications or pre trial hearings in the matter
- any prospects of the matter resolving without the need for a trial
- the names of counsel appearing in the matter
- counsel and witness unavailability during the sitting time
- the expected duration of the trial
- any requirement for CCTV, video conferencing or the recording of evidence
- any other relevant matter which could affect the hearing of the trial.

A trial date for each matter ready to proceed in the sittings will usually be given at the callover.
