NOTICE TO PRACTITIONERS

Registrar's Criminal Directions Lists

Practitioners are advised of the following which applies to matters listed for Criminal Directions before the Registrar:

1. Parties are expected to have complied with any orders or directions made about the filing of documents, or to have approached the court in advance of any deadline to seek an extension.
2. Extension requests should be sent by email to SCRegistrar@courts.act.gov.au copying in all parties to the proceeding. Extension requests will only be considered in chambers if they are expressly by consent. Orders sought which are said to be "not opposed" by another party will not be made in-chambers.
3. Parties should not expect to be able to "file in-court" documents which ought to have been filed in advance of the listing.
4. Practitioners representing an accused or defendant should ensure that their form 4.4 is filed prior to requesting that their client be excused pursuant to section 30 of the *Bail Act 1992*.
