PAYMENTS INTO AND OUT OF COURT

When making a payment into Court the payment must be accompanied by a notice or covering letter setting out details of the proceedings in respect of which the payment is made, the reason for payment in and indicating whether there is an order for payment out and, if so, details of such order. These requirements are in addition to the requirements of Order 26 of the *Supreme Court Rules*.

Where money has been paid into Court that money will not be paid out of Court except in pursuance of an order of the Court and that order must be taken out in accordance with Order 42 of the *Supreme Court Rules*.
