## **SUPREME COURT OF THE AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY Notice to Practitioners**

### **LIST OF AUTHORITIES**

The Court is concerned at a disturbing trend whereby some practitioners have, in some cases, failed to comply with the requirement to provide lists of authorities to the Court through the associates in a timely manner.

The requirement to provide authorities to the Court in accordance with prescribed times applies not only to appeals to the Supreme Court (Practice Direction No 2/99) and Court of Appeal (Orders 42 & 44 and Practice Direction No 1/03) but also to all matters at first instance before the Court.

In matters other than appeals the List of Authorities must be provided to the court at least 2 working days prior to hearing. The timetable for providing authorities in appeals is governed by the Rules of the Practice Direction. Practitioners should provide copies of all cases and all sections of legislation to which reference is intended to be made at the hearing. The copies should be attached to the List of Authorities.

Practitioners should note that legislation is not available in all court rooms.
