Criminal Block Listing Periods for 2023

The Court will hold the following Block Listing periods for the hearing of criminal charges in 2023:

January

Monday 16 January to Friday 27 January 2023 (2 weeks) – General Criminal

February/March

Monday 20 February to Friday 3 March 2023 (2 weeks) – Family Violence

Monday 6 March to Friday 10 March 2023 (1 week) – General Criminal

Monday 20 March to Friday 24 March 2023 (1 week) – General Criminal

April/May

Monday 24 April to Friday 5 May 2023 (2 weeks) – Family Violence

Monday 8 May to Friday 19 May 2023 (2 weeks) – General Criminal

June

Monday 26 June to Friday 30 June 2023 (1 week) – General Criminal

July/August

Monday 3 July to Friday 7 July 2023 (1 week) – General Criminal

Monday 10 July to Friday 28 July 2023 (3 weeks) – Family Violence

Monday 31 July to Friday 25 August 2023 (4 weeks) – General Criminal

August/September

Monday 28 August to Friday 8 September 2023 (2 weeks) – Family Violence

Monday 11 September to Friday 15 September 2023 (1 week) – General Criminal

October/November

Monday 16 October to Friday 27 October 2023 (2 weeks) – Family Violence

Monday 30 October to Friday 17 November 2023 (3 weeks) – General Criminal

December

Monday 4 December to Friday 8 December 2023 (1 week) – Family Violence

Monday 11 December to Friday 15 December 2023 (1 week) – General Criminal

Hearings relating to defendants in custody will generally be given first priority during any block listing periods. Matters not reached will be marked with priority for the next occasion.

Parties should anticipate overlisting of matters.

A Magistrate will conduct a daily callover at 9.30am during the block listing period to allocate matters that are ready to proceed.

The Court will continue to list ad hoc hearings as required.
