Notice to practitioners

***The Non Compliance List
Thursday Criminal Directions List***

Practitioners are advised that, as of today, the so called “shame list” (which was part of the criminal directions list on a Thursday morning) will now be termed the **Non Compliance List**.

The Non Compliance List will now apply to any party in a criminal matter who has failed to comply with Court directions regarding the filing of documents.

Practitioners are reminded that the Court may, upon the committal for trial of an accused person, make directions pursuant to Rule 4733 of the *Court Procedures Rules 2006* requiring the director of public prosecutions (DPP) to file in Court, and provide the accused person’s solicitors, or the accused person if not legally represented (the accused) with a copy of, the draft indictment, case statement, list of proposed witnesses and pre-trial questionnaire completed by DPP, within a certain timeframe. The Court may also make directions pursuant to Rule 4733 requiring the accused to complete and file in Court the pre-trial questionnaire within a certain timeframe.

Where parties (DPP or the accused) do not comply with those directions within the time frames given, the matter will be listed in the Non Compliance List on a Thursday morning and the party who did not comply with the directions will be advised by notice from the Court that they are required to attend.
