**NOTICE TO PRACTITIONERS**

**Callover 30 October 2017**

**Central criminal listing periods  
March-April 2018**

Practitioners are reminded that at the criminal call over on **30 October 2017 at 9.30am**, the representatives of the parties should have full instructions and be prepared to advise the Court as to:

- whether the matter is to proceed by trial by jury or a trial by judge alone (election having been filed)
- any reason why a trial should be allocated to a particular judge
- whether there are any pre trial applications or pre trial hearings in the matter
- any prospects of the matter resolving without the need for a trial
- the names of counsel appearing in the matter
- counsel and witness unavailability during the sitting time
- the expected duration of the trial
- any requirement for CCTV, video conferencing or the recording of evidence
- any other relevant matter which could affect the hearing of the trial.

Matters in the callover will be listed in the March-April 2018 central criminal Listing period, over the following weeks:

- Week commencing 19 March 2018
- Week commencing 26 March 2018
- Week commencing Tuesday 3 April 2018 [*Easter Monday*]
- Week commencing 9 April 2018
- Week commencing 16 April 2018
- Week commencing 23 April 2018
- Week commencing 30 April 2018

Practitioners are advised that there will be a further callover on **Monday 11 December at 9.30am** for any matters not reached in the November-December sittings or matters requiring a retrial, and for other priority matters, with a view to listing those trials in or before the March-April sittings if possible.
