Caveat Searches

Caveat searches will continue to be undertaken by email. The process for this is as follows:

The party applying for probate will send an email to the court at sclisting@courts.act.gov.au and request that the registry conduct a caveat search. Upon receipt of a response to this email, the party applying will then file an affidavit of search based on information and belief.
