NOTICE TO PRACTITIONERS

Change to Probate Notice Requirements

Amendments to the Court Procedures Rules 2006 (ACT), to take effect from 1 March 2022, will change the requirements for publishing a notice of intention to apply (**Notice of Intention to Apply**) for probate, letters of administration, or the reseal of a foreign grant.

From 1 March 2022 all Notices of Intention to Apply will be required to be published online on the ACT Supreme Court website. This will replace the current requirement to publish a Notice of Intention to Apply in a daily newspaper circulating generally in the ACT.

The relevant online forms and details of associated costs to publish a Notice of Intention to Apply will shortly become available on the ACT Supreme Court website.

Existing newspaper advertisements publishing a Notice of Intention to Apply will remain valid provided the advertisement was published not less than 14 days and not more than 3 months before the day the relevant application is filed in Court.
