Notice to practitioners – Civil jurisdiction

Call over arrangements for 31 August 2016

1. A call over of civil matters will be undertaken on 31 August 2016 from 10.00am. Matters have either been adjourned into this list or the legal representatives have recently received a Notice of Listing. A number of the matters have a mediation date in late 2016.

2. At the call-over on 31 August 2016, parties can expect matters to be allocated a hearing date in a central civil list during the following period:

Monday, 6 February 2017 to Friday, 17 February 2017

3. At the call over on 31 August 2016, all parties must appear and be in a position to advise the court in relation to the following:
 - a. The estimated length of the hearing;
 - b. Counsel's and witnesses' available dates during the hearing period;
 - c. A timetable, if possible agreed with the other parties, which will have them ready for hearing by February 2017.

4. If parties have not already done so, a Listing Hearing Questionnaire must be filed by all separately represented parties at least seven (7) days prior to the call over.

5. In the event that a hearing date is allocated during the period referred to in paragraph 2 above, parties will receive a Notice of Listing confirming the date and notice that payment of any hearing fees are payable within 21 days of the date of the notice.
